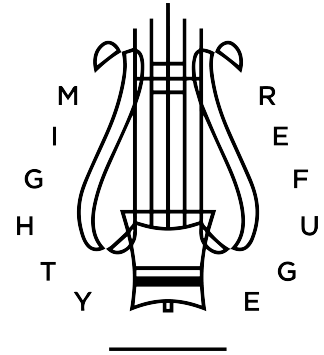


# Just As I Am (All of Me)
